School Social Worker

École Saint-Landry is a tuition-free public charter French-immersion elementary school located in the town of Sunset, Louisiana. We are a Title 1 school, with 67% of our students labeled educationally disadvantaged. Our school is small, tight-knit, and we are looking for the right person to join our school community.

Position Summary: The school social worker assists in addressing the psychological and social well-being of students. The main responsibility is to identify mental or emotional issues that our students face and work with them through those challenges. The position also collaborates with parents and school staff to create coordinated intervention strategies (e.g. behavioral management) and will implement and coordinate a school-wide SEL program.

Immediate Supervisor:

This position reports to the school leader.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Counseling students with personal and psychological issues that affect their performance, behavior, and socialization in school.
- Providing counseling sessions, treatment plans, or workshops as necessary and establishing prevention programs and intervention plans.
- Communicating with students to determine the areas in which they may need assistance or counseling.
- Assisting teachers and administrators with behavioral and attitude issues by communicating with students to find the causes of their distress.
- Providing information, when appropriate, to outside support services to help students with economic, emotional, or physical issues.
- Report to the proper authorities in cases of physical, mental, or emotional abuse.
- Communicating with parents, teachers, and administrators to understand students' challenges.
- Maintaining case files and reports to track students' progress and problems.



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School Social Worker Requirements:

- A bachelor's or master's degree in social work.
- Louisiana license and certification to practice social work.
- Experience in School Social Work preferred.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Bilingual French/English is a plus.
- Compassion and empathy for students and families.
- Professionalism and discretion.
- Good relationships with relevant social services.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Ten (10) months
SALARY: \$45,000
INSURANCE OPTION: Blue Cross/Blue Shield (health/dental/vision)

EVALUATION: Performance in this position will be evaluated in accordance with the Board's policy by the School Leader.
