Remote Learning Days

As explained in our Handbook, École Saint-Landry has several remote learning days scheduled on our Academic Calendar. In order to be counted as present on remote learning days, the student must return the work packet sent home by the teacher for that day on the very next day he or she returns to school. Attendance for the day is based on how much of the packets (usually only English and Math) is turned in complete.

FUNDRAISING THROUGH KINDNESS

RAISE CRAZE™

Raise Craze is an online platform enabling participants to set up secure, custom websites where they request donations via email, text, and social. During the fundraiser, participants pay it forward by completing Acts of Kindness for others. A great way to learn the value of gratitude. Spend time serving not selling!

We want to continue to make our school a better place by providing helpful and enriching benefits to our students & families, but that takes some extra money! We've chosen Raise Craze to help with these needs because it keeps kindness and inclusivity at the center, while allowing our school to keep 90% PLUS!

To participate, visit **Raise Craze** and set up your fundraising page. You'll need to enter our school's code, 613-084. From there, get your child or children choose 3-5 acts of kindness to pledge in exchange for family and friends helping them to meet their fundraising goals. Some examples of acts of kindness include collecting canned goods for our local food pantry, donating gently used books or clothing, delivering a goodie basket to your local fire or police station, chalking a message of kindness on the sidewalk where lots of people will see it, helping to prepare a family meal, folding the laundry, reading a book to a younger sibling...there are so

many possibilities to teach your children to take pride in their work to raise money for a beloved cause.

Several siblings can all have a fundraiser page together, or they can have them separately. They'll share their page with family and friends via email, text, and social media. Emails are never shared or used for marketing.

Our fundraiser will run from September 14th through September 28th, and our goal is \$2000 per class. With our smallest class having ten students, that means each student only needs to raise \$200 from as many sources as it takes--that could be \$5 from 40 people, or \$10 from 20 people.

We'll be sending home the registration and incentive prize letters the second week of September so your child will be ready to start his or her Kindness Hero Mission!

The deadline to sign up is September 30th.

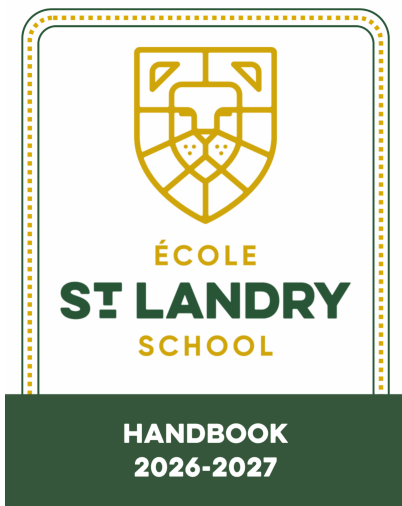

2026-2027 Parent Welcome Packet Published



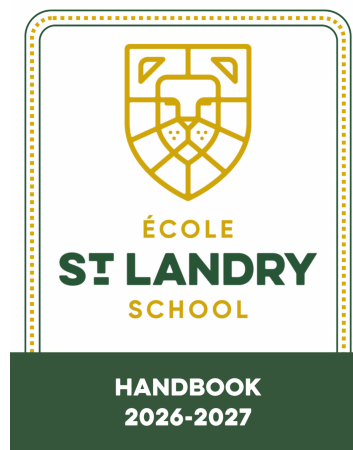

General Information:

Attendance/check-ins and -outs:

If your child is going to be absent, please do not call us. **If your child will be out of school for two or more days**, you can [email us](#) or just send the doctor's excuse in their green folder when they return to school. We can also accept **up to three** hand-written parental excuses per school year. Parental excuses can only cover two consecutive days of absence. If your child is sick longer than that, you will need a doctor's excuse to have the extra days covered. Any excuse must be received within five days of the absence.

You may also request make-up work, homework, and more to be prepared by the teacher for you to pick up in the office.



If you are running late, please remember to sign in your child in the office when you get here. You do not need to let us know in advance.

If you need to check your child out early, please come to the office to sign him out before 3:15 p.m. You do not need to let us know in advance unless you have an official reason for needing to check your child out between 3:15 and 3:45. In that case, please **email us**.

Transportation changes:

If your child is usually a bus-rider but you will be picking him or her up today, or vice-versa, or if you need to leave your child in afternoon Lion Care today, please **email us** before 3:15 p.m.

We request email whenever possible so we have a paper trail of your instructions. If ever you email and we do not reply by 3:15 p.m., please call the office at (337) 510-3022 to confirm that your email was received.
